- 1. First famine broke out on earth in the time of Prophet Abraham.
- 2. Wearing shoes & caps began in the period of Prophet Sheith, son of Adam.
- 3. Cultivation of grapes began in the time of Prophet Noah.
- 4. Fatimid navigators invented *qutb-numa* (mariner compass) in Egypt, whom they called *samia*. The Europe indebted to the Fatimid after five centuries.
- 5. Prophet Solomon is believed to have invented soap.
- 6. Ammar bin Ali, an eye-surgeon in the time of Imam Hakim invented a hollowed metallic needle for the cataract operations.
- 7. Abu Ali Sina was first to find out existence of bacteria in the spread of epidemic.
- 8. Admission of women in police department firstly initiated by Imam Hakim.
- 9. World population was 25 millions in the time of Jesus Christ.
- 10. Imam Sultan Muhammad Shah had a privilege to build first mosque in Britain.
- 11. Naval Commander in Fatimid period was called *Amir al-Bahr* (Chief of the Sea), which came to be copied in Europe as *Admiral*.
- 12. One language was spoken in the world in the time of Prophet Noah.
- 13. Fatimid firstly designed World Map, showing cities, mountains, seas, rivers, etc.
- 14. Curfew Order was firstly introduced in the period of Imam Muiz in Egypt.
- 15. Prophet Idrees was first to write with pen.
- 16. Application of the ice-beg to the head of the sick was the invention of Abu Ali Sina.

- 17. Fatimid firstly developed techniques of attacking ships with fire-throwers, which the English employed five centuries later during routing the Spanish Armada.
- 18. Pir Shams was the first Punjabi poet.
- 19. Ali bin Yonus, an astronomer in the period of Imam Hakim invented pendulum and the sun-dial.
- 20. Services of the Ismaili dais were remunerated profession by Imam Aziz.
- 21. Horse-riding firstly started by Matushlakh, the successor of Prophet Idrees.
- 22. Fatimid was first in the world to start mock fights at sea.
- 23. Theories of astronomy for the first time were propounded by Prophet Idrees.
- 24. Imam Sultan Muhammad Shah was first in the world to be weighed in diamonds.
- 25. Wearing gown in the university was introduced by the Fatimid, known as khaftan.
- 26. House made of bricks was begun in the time of Prophet Noah.
- 27. Sewing the cloth was firstly started in the period of Prophet Idrees.
- 28. Fixed Price system in the markets originally started by the Fatimid.
- 29. First to keep beard was Prophet Sheith.
- 30. Industry of Cairo produced such a fine cloth that a whole robe could be passed through a finger ring in the time of Imam Aziz.
- 31. Fountain pen was invented by Imam Muiz.
- 32. All animals were lawful in the time of Prophet Noah.
- 33. Mummies in Cairo were firstly discovered in the time of Imam Muiz, known as *mmiyah*.
- 34. Hasan bin Sabbah was first to start Guerilla war.
- 35. Fatimid invented safe sulphur match five centuries before it was used in Europe.
- 36. Hazrat Ali was first to propound distance between earth and sun.
- 37. Pir Sadruddin was the first poet of Gujrati and Sindhi.
- 38. The tendency to celebrate Eid al-Milad al-Nabi for the first time on a larger and more festive scale emerged during the Fatimid era in 306/919.

- 39. Yasmin Ratansi is the first Ismaili Muslim woman elected in the Canadian House of Commons.
- 40. First to ride a horse was Prophet Ismael, son of Prophet Abraham.
- 41. Lalak Jan Shaheed is the first Pakistani Ismaili to have won posthumous award of Nishan-e-Haider.
- 42. Rasail Ikhwan as-Safa stands first encyclopedia in the world.
- 43. Imam Zayn al-Abidin was first expounder of the rotation of moon.
- 44. Imam Muhammad al-Bakir is credited to have propounded atomic theory firstly.
- 45. In 1781, William Herschel discovered a planet *Uranus* with the help of telescope. *Uranus* means faint. Before him, Imam Jafar Sadik discovered by calling it *Sukhainah* means slow or faint.
- 46. Imam Jafar Sadik recommended for the first time an invention of instrument to watch an object of a remote distance 50 times nearer. Galileo was destined to invent such instrument in 1610, that is Telescope, bringing an object visible 50 times closer to its actual distance.
- 47. Hazrat Ali was first to make metalled roads in Arab.
- 48. Hazrat Ali was first to patronize education during his Khilafat. Thus, about 2000 students were given free scholarship in Kufa.

49. The Arabic word <u>noor</u> is used 49 times in Holy Koran.
